The Federation of Broomball Associations of Ontario (F.B.A.O.) requires Police Vulnerable Sector Checks according to its Constitution & By-Laws:

B.3.3 Vulnerable Sector Police Check

All bench officials at the Juvenile National Qualifier & Junior Provincials must submit a vulnerable sector police check with their registration. All Senior bench officials with players under 18 must also submit this for all Senior F.B.A.O. events.

After the first year, bench officials will be able to sign a declaration stating that there are no changes. Each check will therefore be valid for a period of 3 years.

National bench officials will still be required to submit a new vulnerable sector police check each year as per C.B.F. requirements.

As such, the requirement also requires the F.B.A.O. to collect an annual Offence Declaration from these individuals. The intent of the requirement is to ensure that F.B.A.O. events are safe for all concerned.

We realize that members may have concerns about their privacy and about how the F.B.A.O. intends to administer the requirements. The F.B.A.O. have developed a plan to meet the requirements while being sensitive to the privacy of each member/volunteer and dealing with members in a straightforward, fair way.
